



## CARBON ACCOUNTING SEMINAR HELD

In response to the call for respect for human dignity and integrity of God's creation, the Center for Environmental Stewardship Core Group was formed and chaired by Sr. Joseline Lasala, SPC, Vice President for Administrative Services. In collaboration with the Research Center, the first Environmental Research Seminar, entitled "Carbon Accounting," with the theme: Establishing the Carbon Footprint Baseline of SPU Manila, was conducted on 24 August 2015 in the Founder's Hall.



The activity was spearheaded by Sr. Joseline Lasala, SPC, together with Dr. Brian Bantugan, Director, Research Center, and Dr. Arsenio Bignotia, Chair, Business Administration and Entrepreneurship Program, of the Transformative Research and Innovation Committee.

It was participated in by faculty members and representatives from the Management Team. The resource speaker for the activity was Mr. Alan Silayan, an independent consultant who works with the private sectors and government agencies for climate change mitigation projects.

Sr. Joseline Lasala, SPC delivered the opening remarks and gave a brief background for the activity. She started with the discussion about Dark Green Campus, followed by the objectives, different strategies, and specific committees under the Center for Environmental Stewardship (CfES) Core Group.



After the introduction, discussions about Climate Change and Carbon Accounting were held. Mr. Alan Silayan (photo left) gave a talk on Greenhouse Gases and Global Warming and their consequences. He also discussed the global response to climate change, as well as the strategies of mitigation and adaptation. The second part of the talk focused on Carbon Accounting and was followed by a workshop.

During the workshop, the attendees participated in the sample computation of the carbon emission of St. Paul University Manila caused by its electrical consumption. Mr. Silayan also enumerated the other possible sources of carbon emission in the campus. There was also an

open forum throughout the workshop. There was a productive exchange of thoughts and ideas between the representatives from the management team and the faculty.

The activity ended with the awarding of the Certificate of Appreciation to Mr. Alan Silayan led by Sr. Ma. Evangelina Anastacio, SPC, University President, assisted by Dr. Brian Bantugan
