ATTY. SABINO D. PADILLA CONFERRED FR. LOUIS CHAUVET AWARD

The Congregation of Sisters of St. Paul of Chartres, Philippine Province conferred the Father Louis Chauvet Award to Atty. Sabino D. Padilla, Jr. on 21 June 2016. The ceremony was held at 5:00 P.M. in the Founder's Hall.

After the processional, the Sisters in Formation led the Invocation and the Philippine National Anthem. Sr. Lilia Thérèse L. Tolentino, SPC, Provincial Superior, gave the Opening Remarks and welcomed the awardee and guests.

The Awarding Ceremony opened with the Introduction of the Awardee by Sr. Marie Rosanne Mallillin, SPC, Chancellor of the St. Paul University System and President of St. Paul University Surigao, and an Audio-Visual Presentation on the awardee, made by his granddaughter. Sr. Maria Nilda Masirag, SPC, Assistant Provincial for Education and President of St. Paul University Quezon City, read the Award Citation.
