Dr. Elizabeth Ramos, Dean of the College of Business and Management, presented her research paper, "Peace through Environmental Stewardship" at the XVII International Conference on Environmental Science and Development held on 20-21 April 2015 in Boston, USA. She was among the more than 30 presentors from other countries—USA, Algeria, Thailand, Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, India, Korea, Iran, Germany, France, United Kingdom, Malaysia, Nigeria, Canada, and Sweden.

ALUMNA ADDRESSES MASSACHUSETTS COLLEGE

Dr. Herminia Festin, physiatrist at Bedford VAMC, presented a lecture on "Traumatic Brain Injury and Spinal Cord Injury" to the staff and students of Regis College in Weston, Massachusetts on 22 April 2015.

The lecture, part of the Regis College Presidential Lecture Series, was open to the public, and included speakers from the Harvard-Spaulding Rehabilitation Center.

According to Regis Series description, "There are more than 11,000 new spinal cord injuries and traumatic brain injuries each year. There are also those who experience amputations due to surgery for illness, and those who are involved in accidents, conflict or terrorism situations. All these individuals are affected physically, emotionally, socially and in their vocational lives. Yet recent advances in both technology and adaptive techniques hold the hope of maximizing their capabilities and addressing their challenges and those of their families.

"The importance of this has been driven home by the plight of returning war veterans, many of whom have lost limbs or endured terrible damage to their motor and cognitive functions. We have confronted the challenges as well in the plights of Boston Marathon bombing victims. Care-givers, patients, and families are called upon to work as teams to help these individuals live life to the fullest."

Dr. Festin is a Staff Physiatrist, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Service, in Bedford VA and Assistant Clinical Professor, BU Medical School.
