BS TOURISM 2011: A SAD TALE OF TWO FRIENDS



In 2011, there were two BS Tourism seniors who were the best of friends: Mizzielle Jamyka Gutierrez (left) and Rojie Suva (right).

Myka never got to graduate. In February, her boyfriend stabbed her to death in his house, where she was using his computer for her thesis. Her assailant is still at large.

Rojie did graduate, and eventually worked as a VIP Host in Resorts World. She was among those who died of asphyxiation during a crazed man's rampage on 2 June. She left behind her husband and two young children.

Two friends, who shared common dreams and aspirations and, unknown to them, a common tragic fate: becoming victims of man's inhumanity to man.
