what is being said. 'Who are you, Lord?' Saul asks. 'I am Jesus, the one you are hurting,' the voice says. Jesus says this because when Saul hurts Jesus' followers, Jesus feels as if he is being hurt himself. Saul now asks: 'What shall I do, Lord?'

'Get up and go into Damascus,' Jesus says. 'There you will be told what you must do.' When Saul gets up and opens his eyes, he can't see a thing. He is blind! So the men with him take him by the hand and lead him into Damascus.

Jesus now speaks to one of his disciples in Damascus, saying: 'Get up, An·a·ni'as. Go to the street called Straight. At the house of Judas ask for a man named Saul. I have chosen him to be a special servant of mine.'

 $An \cdot a \cdot ni$ 'as obeys. When he meets Saul, he lays his hands on him and says: 'The Lord has sent me that you might see again and be filled with holy spirit.' At once something that looks like scales falls from Saul's eyes, and he is able to see again.
