NAPA VISITS THE ELDERLY OF BAHAY PUSO

In coordination with the Community Development Center (CDC) headed by its Manager, Ms. Elvie Manalansan, and Ms. Estelita Bustos, Social Worker, 16 members of the Non-Academic Personnel Association (NAPA), led by Ms. Ivy Coronel, NAPA President, went to visit the *lolas and lolos* in Bahay Puso, Balanga, Bataan on 28 April 2018.

Bahay Puso is a House for the Elderly being managed for the Diocese of Balanga by Sr. Mary Philip Galeno, SPC, Administrator/Superior. Currently, there are about 29 elders in residence. Sr. Philip is assisted by two other SPC Sisters and a few professional care-givers. Prior to her current assignment, Sr. Philip had been Administrator of the SPC Vigil House in Iloilo and Provincial Assistant for Health Ministry in the 1990s.

Residents of the Bahay Puso are not just advanced in age, but most of them are also afflicted with disabilities: deafness, partial or full visual impairments, and learning disabilities.
