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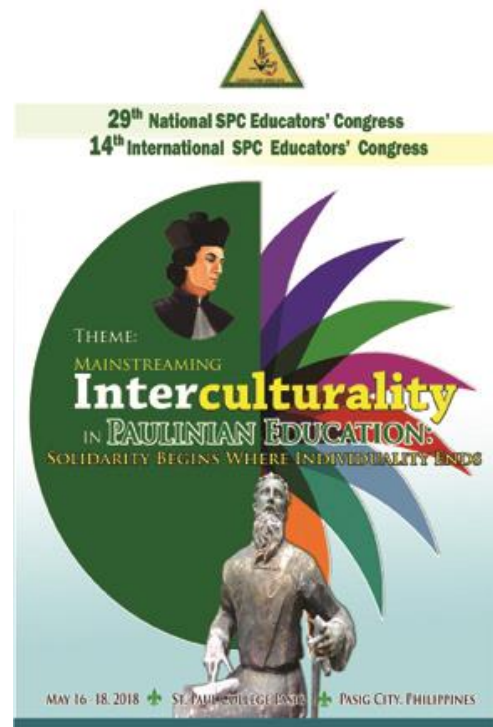
## SPC Philippine Province Holds 29<sup>th</sup> National SPC Educators' Congress and 14<sup>th</sup> International SPC Educators' Congress
