Sr. Evangeline Anastacio, SPC, SPU Manila President bade farewell to the graduating SHS students in this message:

**My dear Paulinians,**

You are standing at a crossroad, one of many crossroads you have arrived at up till now and will arrive at in the future. What road will you choose? Will you proceed to college; and if you do, will you stay in St. Paul University Manila or go to another school? Will you opt to join the work force; and if you do, will you stay in the country or aspire to go abroad? In a few more years, you will come to another crossroad. Will you get married, stay single, or become a religious? If you decide to get married, when, where, and to whom? If you decide to become a religious, which congregation will you choose to enter? There will be choices and choices. And more choices. More crossroads.

I cannot tell you which road to choose. No one can tell you that. It is a decision you have to make by yourself. You can ask advice from your parents, older siblings and other relatives, your teachers, your counselors, your best friends. I am sure they will give you sincere advice, point out pros and cons, advantages and disadvantages; but in the end, you have to make the choice alone.

My hope is that in the two years you have spent in SPU Manila, learning in the classrooms, praying in the chapel, studying in the library, playing in the quadrangle, watching cultural shows in the theatre, spending time with friends in the campus, you have learned how to think critically, how to pray fervently, how to study seriously, how to play fairly, how to appreciate art and music and drama, how to make new friends and keep old ones. In short, I hope the two years you have spent in SPU Manila have prepared you to make clear, informed, and intelligent choices.

Look at the paths that you see at the crossroad. Think. And think hard. Then choose.

I remind you of the words of the poet, Robert Frost:

Two roads diverged in a wood, and I—  
I took the one less traveled by,  
And that has made all the difference.

Whatever road you choose to take, know that your choice will make all the difference. Know also that whatever you decide, should you need guidance or help in the future, you can always come back to your school and we will be here for you.
