



RECENT AND COMING ACTIVITIES

SPU Manila is gearing for a number of year-end and pre-opening activities this month. Here is a rundown of what has happened and what to expect in the coming weeks.

On 2 July 2019, the Community Development Center and the College of Business and Management held the first Livelihood Training Program for the KAISAKA from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 NN. Tertiary Special Term final examinations were held on 12-13 July and the MARED Program ended on the 13th.

The 2018-2019 Management Review will be held today and will be followed by the Operational Planning for 2019-2020 tomorrow.

A highlight of this month's activities will be the Pre-Opening Activities for the AY 2019-2020 on July 31-August 2, 2019 with the theme, "Journeying in Intentional Discipleship."

The Pre-Opening Activities are held annually and attended by all administrators, faculty, and staff of SPU Manila. With the theme centered on "Intentional Discipleship," the activities will enable the participants to influence the evolving culture of education and pedagogy with the clear purpose of molding the learners' heads, hands, and most especially hearts, the soul of education; to develop skills and competencies that will equip them to respond to the challenges of the Fourth Industrial Revolution; and to heighten their sense of mission to accompany the learners in their journey towards wholeness.
