A FORTNIGHT IN THE USA

Sherry Lara-Alingod, President of the St. Paul Manila Alumni Foundation Inc. (SPMAFI), and Marionette Ocampo-Martinez, SPU Manila Institutional Communications and Alumni Relations Officer, went to the USA on a two-week goodwill mission. This was the third trip that they had undertaken, the first two being in 2012 and 2016.

The tandem visited three cities—Alexandria, Virginia, with a side trip to Maryland; New York, NY; and Los Angeles, California. In Virginia, they attended the events of the Paulinian Global Foundation, Inc.—the dinner dance fund-raiser for the Vigil House, wine-tasting, and special Mass in the Basilica—and other gatherings (HS 1966, HS 1965, HS 1969, and a big group of different classes). In New York, they met with HS 1965 and BSN 1971. In LA, they attended a big reunion with 52 attendees (including husbands), from different SPCM batches. The event was covered by *The Asian Journal* and *The Filipino Reporter*.

Mrs. Alingod sold bags and t-shirts, as well as raffle tickets for the homecoming. Mrs. Martinez presented the Hundred Dollars for a Hundred Dreams outreach and received dollar donations from alumnae and friends amounting to P393,381.95 (peso conversion).

Over and above the monetary returns of the trip, the tandem gives much value to the friendship and camaraderie, the renewed interest in and love for alma mater that it generated. Their hosts in all places spent considerable time, effort, and money taking care of their every need. The gatherings they attended resounded with laughter and some tears, as nostalgic recollections of their student days, the Sisters and lay teachers, filled the air with the love that Paulinians anywhere in the world have for their school and for one another.

NASA's efforts to engage a broader audience in exploration through the use of social media and online features was recognized with two Emmy Awards for interactive programming this weekend. During ceremonies held Sept. 14-15 at the Microsoft Theatre in Los Angeles, the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences recognized NASA for its coverage of a Mars mission and the agency's first test of a spacecraft that will help bring crewed launches to the International Space Station back to U.S. soil.
