Paulinian Psychology Circle

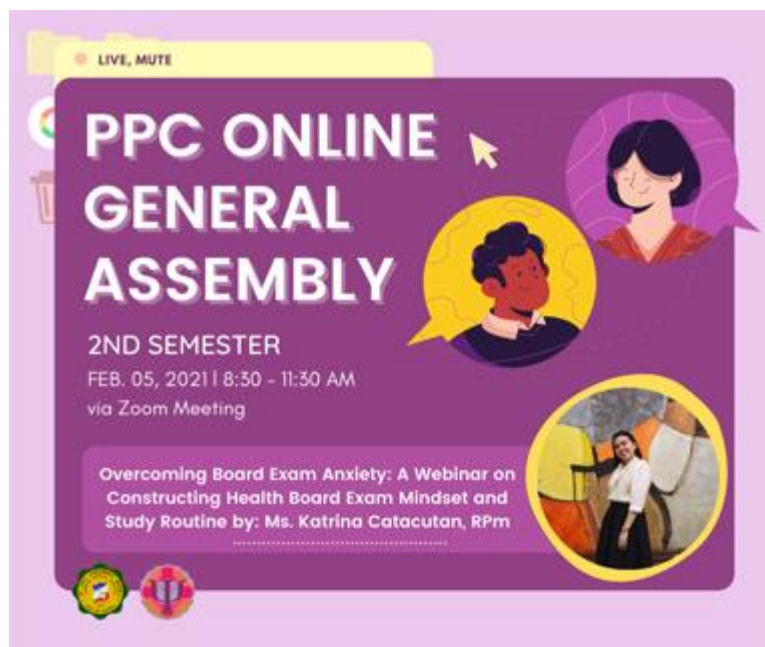
Chloe Cruz, President of the Paulinian Psychology Circle, shares this news:
