

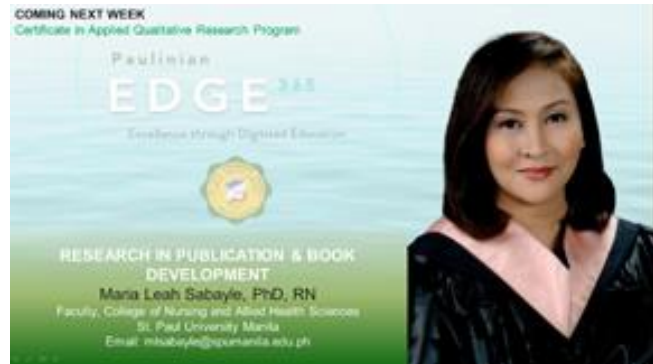


## SPU MANILA IN PANDEMIC TIMES

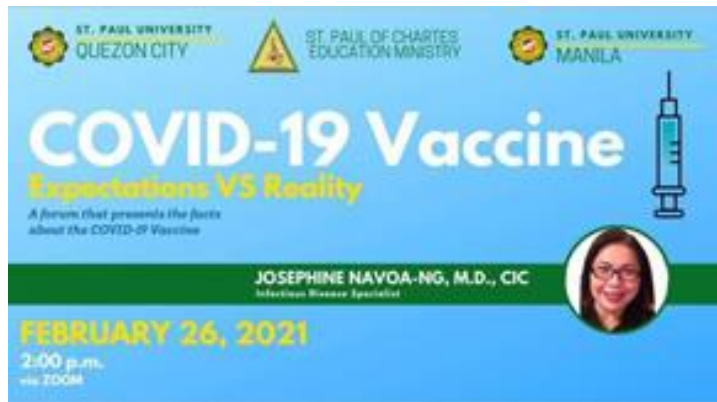

Moderating this webinar were Dr. Jennifer Olivar and Professor Lalaine Mallari.

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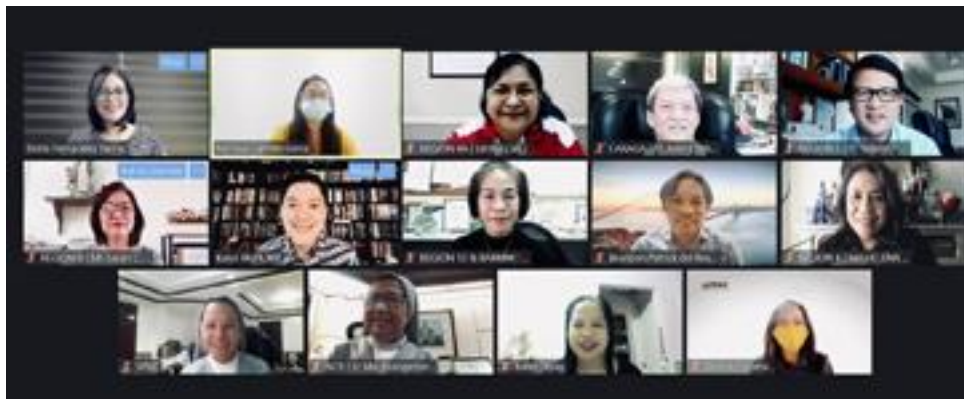
