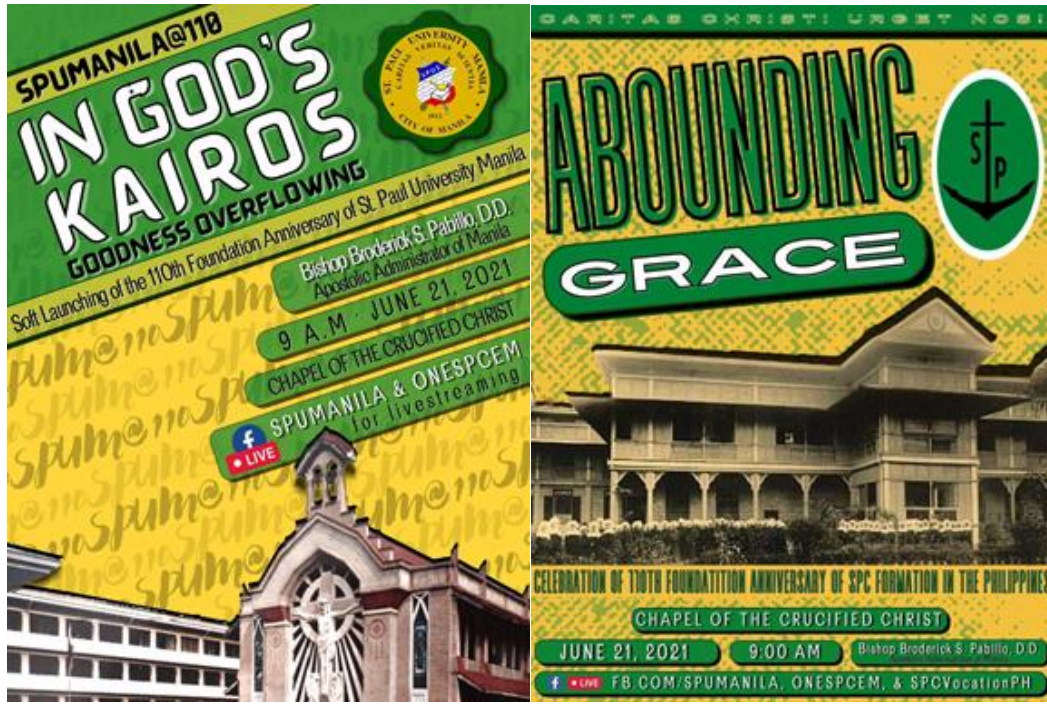


IN THESE PANDEMIC TIMES...

Today, we also celebrate the 311th Death Anniversary of our holy founder, Fr. Louis Chauvet. 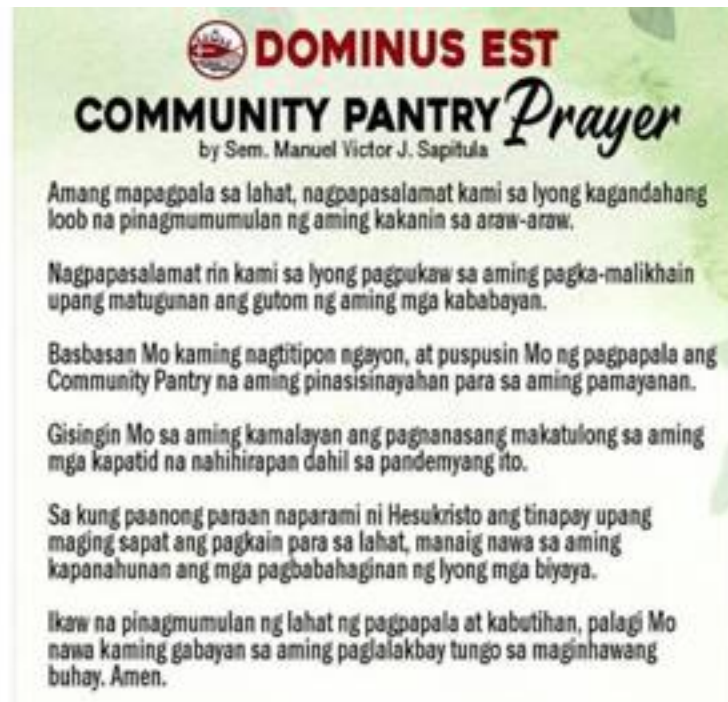


AND A TIME FOR SHARING...

St. Paul University Manila-Barangay 697 Community Pantry became a pantry on wheels.



We were ready with 500 packs of goodies from HS Batch '75 and bread from BSC Batch '80. But we did not want our event to become a super-spreader of the virus. So, after catering to 101 participants from Barangay 697 in our campus, we brought the pantry to three other barangays—namely, 699, 698, and 696. When we came back to the school, there were still enough packs for 26 maintenance staff, seven guards, three garbage collection staff, 25 taxi and pedicab drivers, and 26 construction workers, which they shared with 26 other peers.
