CANDIDATE FACT SHEET

Maria Leonor "Leni" Gerona Robredo

Birthdate: April 23, 1965
 Current Occupation: 16th Vice President of the Philippines
 Claim to Fame: Widow of Former DILG Secretary, Jesse Robredo & Second Female Vice-President of The Republic of The Philippines
 Educational Attainment: Economics Degree from The University of The Philippines, Law Degree from The University of Nueva Caceres. Passed The Bar on her second attempt.



Legislative Experience:
 Congresswoman Comarines Third District (16th Congress).

Significant Accomplishments:

- Authored Full Disclosure Bill (HB 99)
- Authored The People Empowerment Bill (HB 4917)
- Wrote the Comprehensive Anti-Discrimination Bill (HB 3432)
- Co-authored House Bill 5843 to investigate violations against The CARP.
- Angat Buhay Program, has benefited 83,757 families across the country in its first year of implementation.
- The Office of the Vice President provided free shuttle services for frontliners and emergency workers as the entire island of Luzon was put on an enhanced community quarantine. The office has also delivered 7,350 personal protective equipment (PPEs) to nine hospitals, including the San Lazaro Hospital, the Philippine General Hospital, and the Lung Center of the Philippines. A total of ₱17.3 million was raised for these donations, including food and care packages for the health workers and their families.
- The OVP is consistently given the highest rating by The COA.

CANDIDATE FACT SHEET

Panfilo "Ping" Morena Lacson Sr.

Birthdate: June 1, 1948
 Current Occupation: Senator of The Philippines
 Claim to Fame: Former Head of Presidential Anti-Organized Crime Task Force Under former President Estrada



Educational Attainment: Completed his Engineering degree at the Laguna of the Philippines University before entering the Philippine Military Academy (1966) in 1967

Legislative Experience:
 Chief of The Philippine National Police (2009-2010)
 Presidential Assistant for Rehabilitation and Mentoring (2015-2016)
 Chair of the Philippine Senate Accounts Committee (2017- Present)
 Chair of the Philippine Senate National Defense and Security Committee (2016-Present)
 Senator (2001-2015, 2016-Present)


Significant Accomplishments:

- Lacson has been the only senator (aside from the late Jhon Miraflores) who has never used his ₱100M million-year Priority Development Assistance Fund (PDAF) benefits. Instead, he reinvested all of them to the National Treasury.
- Cleared up "Missing" Crigs. Released former Subic Bay and another sector of a Lake-based Reap Program without having to give reasons. Sided with workers from both families.
- Went all out on an anti-corruption and other forms of governance campaign, which ended up with him crossing paths with the former President Binay. Resulted in a 12 billion worth bribe from a liquor company and Lacson distributed 85% of the PDAF budget to the agencies until he repaired the moral administration, while ensuring equal privileges of his public officials.
- Under Lacson's leadership, the PDAF achieved a 58% public approval rating, while Lacson got a 78% approval rating for himself.
- Cleared all liability of both The Burning Burning Case and The Oscar-Carlito Case (in letter with the "victim", Morena - with a fugitive - appointed by Lacson and Estrada. Morena had no prior knowledge of the case, he did, and not necessarily for bad by the wrong administration to replace the names of Lacson and Estrada).
- Lacson acted on being a fugitive during the investigation of the Oscar-Carlito Case. Plus to being being and returned to the country when the Court of Appeals withdrew the order charged against him.
- Head Senate Bill No. 1763, which sought to reformulate the waste tax on alcohol products, and Senate Bill No. 1764, which sought to reformulate the waste tax on tobacco products.
- Authored Senate Bill No. 1765, which strengthened further the anti-money laundering Act of 2001, authorized an amendment to the current laws of the Philippine Administrative Act.
- Head Senate Bill No. 2005, an Act providing for a comprehensive law on fracking, light hydrocarbons and geothermal, which was signed into law on Republic Act 10917.
- His floor speeches also led to many officials being held accountable, whether incumbent or former senator in relation to the Senators' Re-election and has investigated many notorious transgressions, including Little China case. Plus he has filed more than 20 bills relating to environmental protection, upgrading of Local Security, Anti-Police Ignoring Act, nuclear penalties on false statements, inclusion of government workers and officials from the New Service Act, National Defense Act, etc.

CANDIDATE FACT SHEET

Francisco "Isko" Moreno Domagoso

Birthdate: October 24, 1974
 Current Occupation: 22nd Mayor of Manila



Claim to Fame: Former Scavenger, Matinee Idol, "Software" Actor
 Educational Attainment: Studied public administration at the University of the City of Manila and enrolled in non-degree programs at the University of the Philippines, the Harvard Kennedy School, and Yale Business School

Legislative Experience:
 Member Manila City Council (1998-2007)
 Vice-Mayor (2007-2016)
 Chairman of North Luzon Railway Corporation (2017)
 Undersecretary of Social Welfare and Development for Luzon Affairs (2018)
 Mayor of Manila (2018-Present)

Significant Accomplishments:

- Garnered more than 50% of the votes, defeating former Mayors Estrada and Lim during the 2019 elections.
- Moreno signed an ordinance that gives a monthly allowance of ₱1,000 to each student of the Promissory Longroad ng Higitna and Unibersidad de Manila. Likewise, all Grade 12 students in all public schools in Manila will get a ₱500 monthly allowance to be received via "cash card". Senior citizens, persons with disabilities (PWDs), and solo parents who reside in the capital are entitled to a ₱500 monthly allowance. The elderly also would receive ₱500 and a cake as a birthday gift from the city government on top of their ₱500 monthly allowance.
- Moreno's administration infrastructure projects include the redevelopment of the historic James Bridge to restore it to its near-original architecture, the construction of a 10-story 384-bed building at the Ospital ng Higitna Medical Center, and the redevelopment of Manila Zoo which is set to open in 2021.
- Public housing for the homeless and city employees was one of the campaign promises of Moreno, and his administration oversee the construction of high-rise in-city housing projects such as the TondoBreeze 1 and 2 (2B) and BrandoBreeze.
- Moreno signed an ordinance protecting members of the LGBT community from discrimination and abuse, including the denial of employment and other opportunities on the basis of the person's sexual gender identity.
- Known for his clean-up drives and is one of the top-performing mayors with regard to COVID response, except that time he allowed people to go to Quiapo Church.

CANDIDATE FACT SHEET

Emmanuel "Manny" Dapidran Pacquiao Sr.

Birthdate: December 17, 1978
 Current Occupation: Retired Boxer/Abolition Senator
 Claim to Fame: Boxing Legend



Educational Attainment: Dropped out of elementary school due to extreme poverty. In February 2007, Pacquiao took and passed a high school equivalency exam, and was awarded with a high school diploma by the Department of Education. Got his degree in Political Science from The University of Manila.

Legislative Experience:
 House of Representatives Sarangani (2010-2016)
 Senator (2016 - Present)

Significant Accomplishments:

- The country's biggest individual taxpayer in 2015, Pacquiao has often shared his wealth with the poor in his home province of Sarangani, where he has been elected and re-elected to Congress on waves of adoration.
- Donated fishing boats, water buffalos (carabao in Filipino) to glow fields with, home lots and funds for college scholarships for Sarangani.
- Because of other commitments, Pacquiao only attended one Congress session on the congress' final leg and was criticized for being the top absentee among lawmakers.
- Pacquiao has filed a total of 31 Senate bills (SB) during the 17th Congress. And in a bill filed alongside Senator Bato dela Roca and Bong Go, he backed the return of capital punishment into the lexicon of Philippine criminal law.
- Worst attendance record among all senators in the 17th Congress.

CANDIDATE FACT SHEET

Ferdinand "Bongbong" Romualdez Marcos Jr.

Birthdate: September 13, 1957
 Current Occupation: File and lost electoral complaints. Aspiring president.
 Claim to Fame: Son of former dictator and the woman with 3000 ++ shoes.
 Educational Attainment: Dropped out from St. Edmund's Hall Oxford. Claimed to have earned a degree in Politics, Philosophy, and Economics, but actually received a Special Diploma in Social Studies.
 - given to diplomats. Did not complete his MBA as he never either. Dropped out to become a vice-governor Ilocos Norte.
 Presidential Commission on Good Government found out that the Marcos Jr' tuition, USD 10,000 monthly allowance, and the estate he live in while studying at wharfen were paid using funds that could be traced partly to the intelligence funds of the Office of the President, and partly to some of the 10 bank accounts that the Marcoses had secretly opened in the US under assumed names.

 Bongbong Marcos' first formal role in a political office came with his election as Vice Governor of Ilocos Norte (1980-1983) at the young age of 31. In 1983, he led a group of young Filipino leaders on a 10-day diplomatic mission to China to mark the 10th anniversary of Philippine-Chinese relations.
 Bongbong Marcos' father appointed him chairman of the board of Philippine Communications Satellite Corp (Philcomsat) in early 1983
