The year was 1959.

This iconic photo features Paulinian student leaders of St. Paul College of Manila, namely Teresita Bagaybagayan (Bayot), Wilhelmina Ilagan (Basa), Zenaida Reyes (Alfariz) and Ma. Antonia Ayesa (Molina). It was a magazine feature on school uniforms.

The Philippines, at this time, was a young, exuberant, and independent nation. It was working towards rebuilding and developing a nation ravaged by the war.

Some of the major events that took place in the Philippines in 1959 were: Lanao was divided into the new provinces of Lanao del Norte and Lanao del Sur; the province of Southern Leyte was created; the 10th World Scout Jamboree was held at Mt. Makiling; the lease of the American military bases was reduced from 99 years to 25 years; and US authorities turned over Olongapo City to the Philippine government.
