THREE YEAR STRATEGIC PLANS PRESENTED

The SPU Manila Strategic Plans 2020-2023, derived from the SPCEM Strategic Directions, were presented to the SPU Manila Community on 30 October 2020. Those who are working from home attended via Zoom while those who were in the campus attended the activity in the Founders' Hall.

After the opening prayer led by Sr. Donnalyn Morta, SPC, a brief introduction was given by Oliver Rodriguez highlighting the idea of Quick Response (QR) Teams, which were created as the University's response to the new normal.

The Strategic Plans were then reported by Ms. Maridel Negradas. The presentation of the plans and projects of the QR Teams followed, starting with the Financial, Human, and Material Resources Management Team, led by Sr. Ma. Evangeline Anastacio, SPC. Her presentation was shared with Dr. Arsenio Bignotia, who heads the Marketing QR Team.

This was followed by presentations from the Holistic Well-Being Team, the Flexible Teaching-Learning Team, and the Knowledge, Innovation and Quality Management Team led by Ms. Elmgay Valeriano, Dr. Marichen Dychangco, and Dr. Brian Bantugan respectively.

A message from Sr. Evangeline Anastacio, SPC opened the second half of the activity. Central to her message is the idea that we all work together and that no one will be left behind.

Given that one of the projects of the Financial, Human, and Material Resources Management Team was a QR Team Blast-off, a commissioning rite prepared by Sr. Nicole Dabalus, SPC closed the program. During the commissioning, the documents containing the plans and projects of the University were ceremonially offered, along with prayers to be the best that we can be in order to best serve the Paulinian community, knowing that this is but the first step in a very long journey towards SPU Manila 2023.
